During this term our topics are Famous Authors, Rocks and Community.

English:

Learning and using alternative spellings and pronunciations of sounds already known. Reading a range of stories by different authors. Completing Biographies and book reviews. Writing a variety of text types such as: newspaper reports, persuasive texts, letters, diary entries and descriptive writing.

Maths:

Number and place value.
Four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division)
Fractions (decimals and percentages), Measures and Geometry (properties of shapes; position; direction and motion)
Statistics

Science:

Exploring the hardness and permeability of rocks.
Classifying plants and looking at the lifecycle of plants.

Computing:

Using technology in and around school to create purposeful work.
To use a variety of software packages to collect information.

RE:

Learning about Community and ones within our area, Sikhism, Giving and Receiving and Self Discipline.

Art and Design: To research designers and architects so these pieces can be recreated.

DT:

To learn about nutrition and cooking.

Geography:

Locational knowledge exploring the UK
Naming and locating counties and cities of the UK.

History:

A local history study tracing over several aspects of national history which is reflected within the locality.

PE:

Dance (with Francesca); Swimming and Football with Brian Honour.

Citizenship & Rights Respecting:
