Donation to the FEED (Food Emergency East Durham) Project.

On behalf of the East Durham Trust FEED Project and the many local people it has supported, I would like to take this opportunity to express heartfelt thanks for your kind and generous donation in support of our Foodbank here at East Durham Trust.

The last year has seen our local community face an unprecedented crisis in the form of the Covid-19 pandemic. Coronavirus and its impact on our already struggling community has put our FEED food parcel service under huge pressure and we have only been able to meet this demand thanks to support from people like you.

Since the pandemic began in March 2020, charitable donations have enabled us to provide 7840 emergency food parcels to 3550 adults and 2371 children, supporting them through this never before seen hardship. Thank you once again!!
