The Season of Advent: Today we begin the season of Advent – which marks the beginning of the Church's New Year. During the first two weeks of Advent we think about Our Lord's second coming among us at the end of time and then as Christmas draws near we celebrate his first coming among us as a helpless little baby in the stable at Bethlehem. Let us use this season to draw closer to the Lord.

<u>The Advent Wreath</u>: Round - symbolises Eternity. Greenery - Eternal Life. Purple ribbons - symbol of repentance - Penance. Holly & Berries- the Blood that Christ will shed for us. Purple candles (3) - 1st, 2nd & 4th Sunday of Advent. Pink (1) - 3rd Sunday of Advent - Gaudete Sunday which means "rejoice" as Christmas draws near. A candle is lit each weekend to symbolise Christ the light of the world drawing closer. White candle - lit at Christmas to celebrate the fact that Christ is born and is with us.


