Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> November, Parliament passed into law the Regulations governing many aspects of activity in the whole of England until 2nd December. These Regulations prohibit the gathering of people for communal worship in churches and other religious buildings.

**Diocesan Communications Update**

On Tuesday 10 November 2020 at midday, the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse (IICSA) will publish its investigation report into the Catholic Church of England and Wales.

Dioceses have been advised that all media enquiries will be handled centrally by the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales (CBCEW).

More information will follow once the report is published.

I would ask that we keep all victims of abuse in our prayers and ask God's forgiveness for these terrible crimes.
