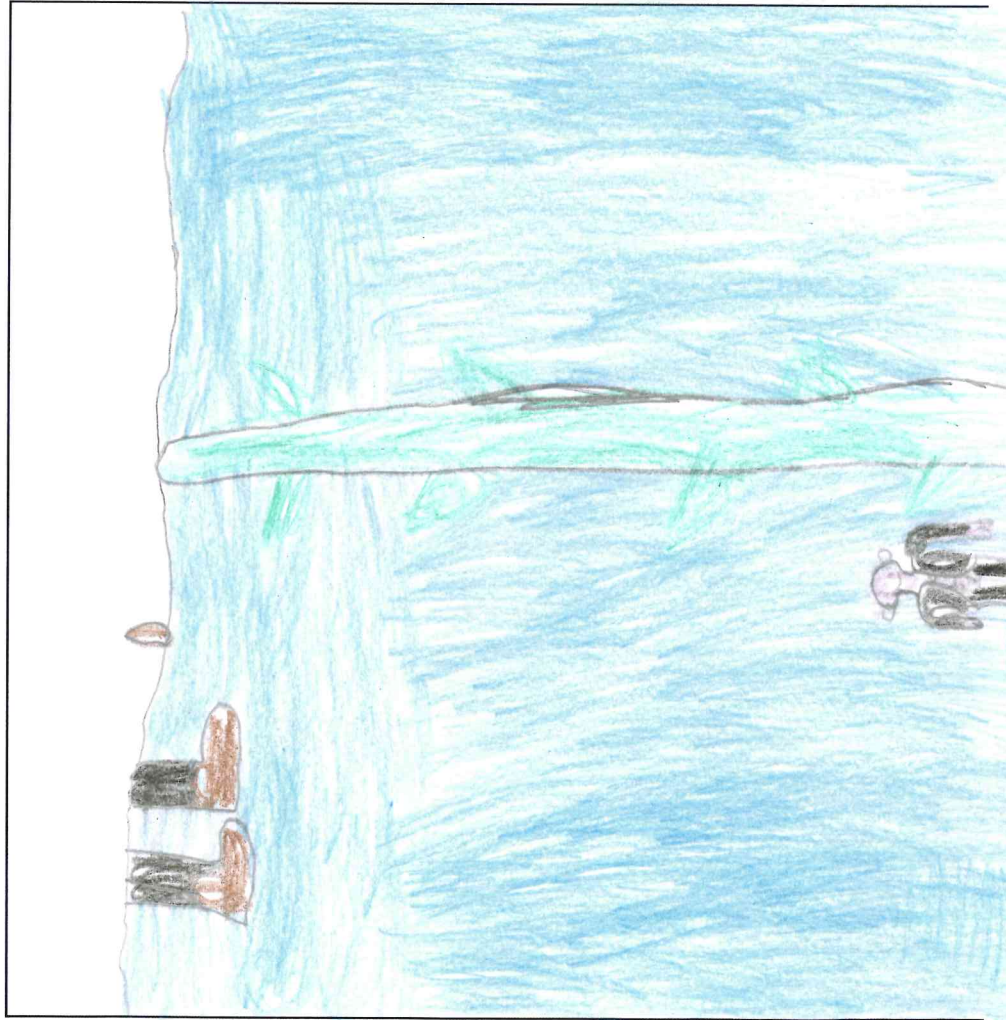

English:

During this term our topics are Plants and Living things

Learning and using new phonic sounds and spelling patterns. Reading a range of stories by different authors.
 Reading and writing traditional tales. Researching the works of authors using a range of materials.
 Poetry-Flower Poems (Reciting/ performing a Range to an audience and Offering Opinions) Writing calligrams (shape poetry). To read and write instructions Writing a Simple Recipe for vegetable soup linked to Design and Technology. Non-Fiction-Writing a Recount about a visit.

Maths:

Number and place value.
 Addition and subtraction using partitioning and sequencing.
 Multiplication & Division, arrays and sharing. Times table facts.
 Measures & Geometry: Shape, position and movement. Measuring including standard and non-standard units. Reading and writing the time.
 Fractions: finding fractions of quantities, shapes and sets of objects.

Science:

Identifying and labelling common plants. Classifying plants. Observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow. Recording data over time.
 Exploring and comparing the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. Identifying that animals live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants.

Computing:

Using technology in and around school to create purposeful work.
 Use digital cameras to take photos.
 Use stitch app to take photos of different plants, label them and create an oral description for their diagram. Creating travel posters.

RE:

Spread the word- Pentecost a time to spread the good news.
 Rules- Reasons for rules in the Christian family.

Art and Design:

Creating form, texture and pattern through Clay relief work linked to plants. Collage- using colour a mixture of different media and textures.

D&T:

Design, make and evaluate a purposeful product- vegetable soup.

History:

Investigate holidays now and then, making comparisons between the past and now, forms of travel, entertainment, locations, weather and clothing.

Geography:

Investigate where different plants grow linked to the 7 continents and 5 oceans. Why these plants grow there. Comparing weather conditions between the continents. Weather linked to countries and the equator.

PE:

SAQ and Games and outdoor adventurous activities.

Citizenship &

Rights Respecting: Promoting children's rights and understanding globality.

Music:

Exploring a range of high quality music through Charanga music. Listening and singing, using our bodies to keep the beat incorporating dances.

Languages:

Working with the language assistant to learn and use French words and phrases.
