

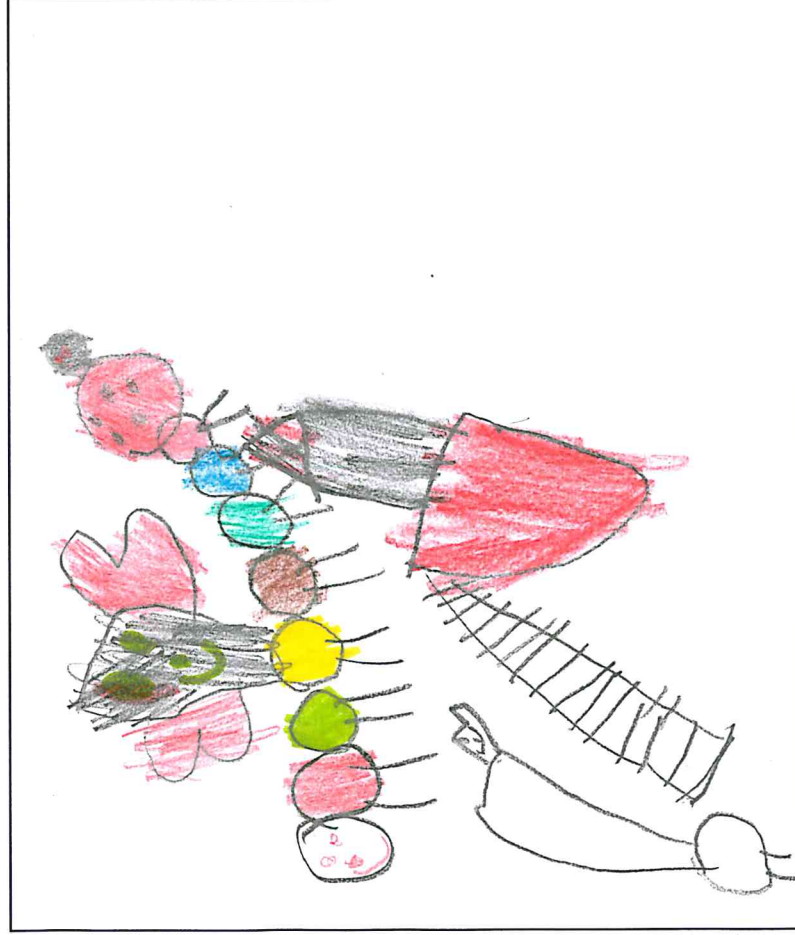
St Joseph's Primary School

We start have various topics to explore, as suggested on the light bulbs the children brought home before Easter. So far these ideas include animal life cycles, picnics, insects, mountains and countries and many more will surely follow!

Teaching and learning will broadly follow the interests of the children but will also include aspects of the Early Learning Goals (ELGs) but also trying to build resilience and independence. Little J's will cover the same themes but at their level of interest and ability, focusing mainly on the Prime areas of learning (red) but also aspects of the Specific areas (blue).

In Personal, Social & Emotional Development we will:

- Listen attentively and respond appropriately.
- Answer 'how' and 'why' questions about things we've experienced.
- Expressing own views about stories or events.

In Communication and Language we will:

- Show awareness of the listener with increased range of vocab.
- Take on-board others' ideas and help to organise activities

In Physical Development we will:

- Handle equipment and tools, including pencils, effectively
- Talk about the ways to keep healthy and know why this is important.

In Literacy we will:

- Give meaning to marks made
- Break the flow of speech into words

In Mathematics we will:

- Begin to read and write numerals up to 20
- Record using marks they can explain and interpret

In Understanding the World we will:

- Look closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change
- Learn about other countries and cultures

In Expressive Arts and Design we will:

- Use simple tools and techniques competently and safely.
- Manipulate materials to achieve a planned effect
- Choose particular colours to use for a particular purpose

Activities to complete at home will be sent out accordingly i.e. Phonics & reading books, R.E. tasks, Maths homework, etc.
