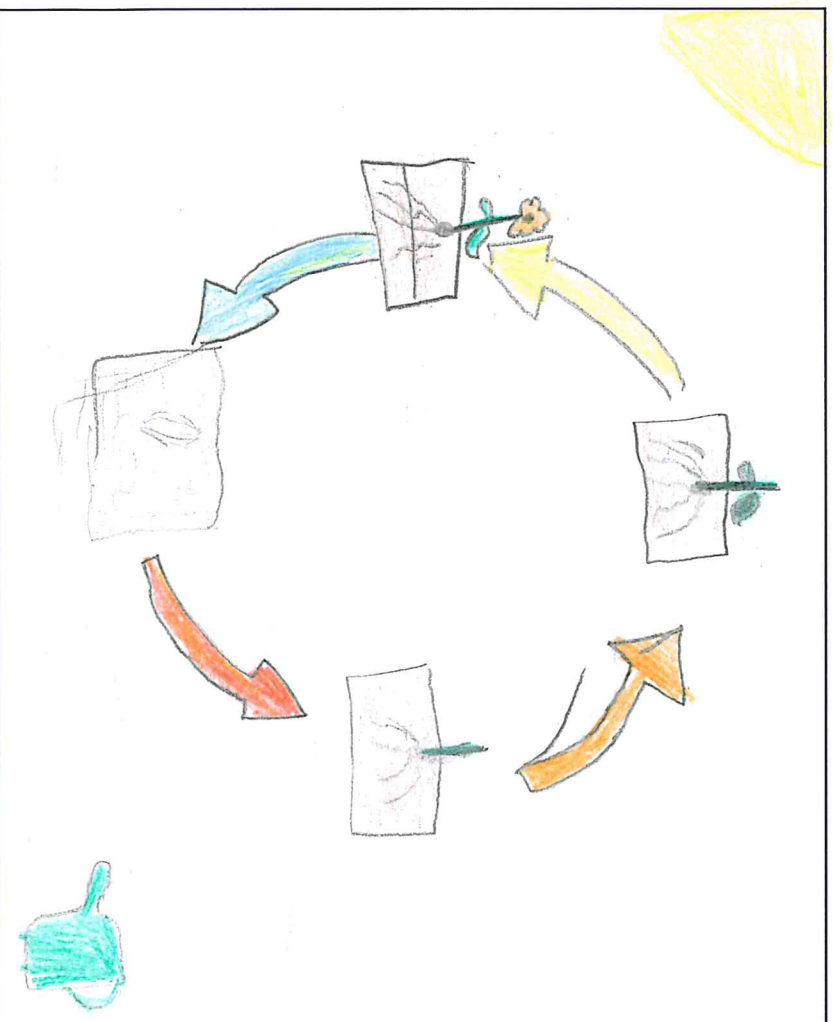

During this term our topics are Comparing People and Places and The Aztecs

English:

Speaking and listening activities are crucial to each unit of work and are always incorporated into our lessons. Your child will be studying a range of fiction and non-fiction texts this term. In writing we will cover a range of texts including poetry, non-chronological reports and fiction. Children will also investigate spelling patterns. The National Curriculum includes statutory spelling rules and lists for each year group. Your child will be given Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation homework each week.

Maths:

Number and Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Fractions (decimals and percentages), Measures, Geometry: properties of shape, Geometry: position, direction and motion, Statistics

Science:

Living Things and Habitats Life cycles of animals and plants. Life processes. Classification

Computing:

Computing – Kodu -Create a virtual 3D world. Kodu – Create a racing game where the vehicle is controlled by the keyboard. Add scoring systems and more game objectives. Digital Literacy – Effective searching. Handling information -Spreadsheets

RE:

Transformation. Freedom and Responsibility. Stewardship

Art and Design: Improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting and sculpture with a range of materials. Dioramas.

D & T:

Investigate what the Aztecs ate. Prepare and cook Mexican dishes using a range of cooking techniques.

History:

Who were the Aztecs? Aztec empire, society and daily life.

Geography:

Where did the Aztecs live?

PE:

Cricket and Athletics. SAQ and OAA

Citizenship & Right Respecting: Promoting children's rights and understanding globally.

Music:

Exploring a range of high quality music through Charanga music.
