Class 1 Autumn Term 2019 Planning



Term Dates: Autumn half-term: Friday 25th October 2019
Return to school: Monday 4th November 2019
Christmas holidays: Friday 20th December 2019

We start with various welcome topics and baseline activities. The light bulbs the children complete will help us plan out some of the topics we'll cover so please do ensure you complete these with your child.

Teaching and learning will broadly follow the interests of the children but will also include aspects of the Early Learning Goals (ELGs). Little J's will cover the same themes but at their level of interest and ability, focusing mainly on the Prime areas of learning (red) but also aspects of the Specific areas (blue).

In Personal, Social & Emotional Development we will:

- Begin to learn about children's rights
- Learn to take turns and share fairly
- Learn to dress and undress independently

In Communication and Language we will:

- Learn to listen to and follow instructions with confidence
- Begin to explore the meaning of new words
- Experiment with language in imaginative role play

In Physical Development we will:

- Learn the importance of good health, exercise and a healthy diet
- Show good co-ordination in large and small movements

In Literacy we will:

- Give meaning to marks made
- Break the flow of speech into words

In Mathematics we will:

- Begin to read and write numerals up to 20
- Record using marks they can explain and interpret

In Understanding the World we will:

- Look closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change
- Learn about other countries and cultures

In Expressive Arts and Design we will:

- Use simple tools and techniques competently and safely.
- Manipulate materials to achieve a planned effect
- Choose particular colours to use for a particular purpose

Activities to complete at home will be sent out accordingly i.e. Phonics & reading books, R.E. tasks, Maths homework, etc. The children all have log in cards to use Purple Mash and Bug Club (school subscribed sites) at home.
