Our class novel this term is 'Who Let The Gods Out'. We look forward to sharing this together in class whilst we explore life in Ancient Greece. We will also be looking at the book 'Flotsam' by David Wiesner.

In **Maths**, we will continue to develop our skills using the four main operations $(+ - x \div)$ and apply these to

reasoning and problem solving questions. We will also develop our skills when working with measurement, fractions and decimals. We will have a big focus on Times Tables, as children in Year 4 will carry out online Times Tables tests later in the year. Please practice these regularly at home, all the way up to 12×12 and remember to use Times Tables Rock Stars and PurpleMash online software to support learning in school.

Our topic this term in history is **Ancient Greece**. We will be finding out what life was like and the impact the Greeks had on our life today. In **Geography**, we will be finding out the features of Earth including Hemispheres and the Equator. We will look at the impact a countries

position has on climate and make a comparison between the UK and a Polar region.



Our **RE** topic is Community. We will explore some deep questions...




What is a community?

This is also the Year of the Word so we will be sharing more Bible stories during our weekly story times.

This term in **Science** we will be learning about states of matter and how they change from one state to another. We will then move onto sound where we will recognise how sound travels and find patterns in pitch and volume.
