When you go for your daily exercise, look closely at the different buildings you can see in Blackhall such as churches, different types of houses, schools and shops. Can you tell which buildings are the oldest and which were built more recently?

Science – Bug Hunt – Find a habitat (hedgerow, grass, stones, trees, flower beds) and search for some bugs. How many can you find? Can you identify them? Make sure you don't disturb the bugs or their habitat. Don't forget to wash your hands after exploring. Create a drawing or model of a bug you have found.

Draw or make a model of the pit wheel. Look at the photo of St Joseph's being built way back in 1955. What do you notice? What has changed? Draw a picture of how our school looks now. Write about how our school building has changed.
