Day	Focus: Addition- Counting on
Monday	https://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/whackAMole/index.html Counting in steps of 1, remember to start from different starting points — not always zero! Challenge them to see how far they can go in a given time. Also try this — https://www.tvokids.com/preschool/games/caterpillar-count please forgive the American accent!
Tuesday	Board games with dice are brilliant to help develop counting on — snakes and ladders is especially good. Get them to make the 'board' they could theme it so not necessary up the ladders and down the snakes. For example: up the castles and down the dragons, up the unicorns, down the broomsticks or link to their focus on toys from the past?) Encourage the children to write the numbers in the squares, even overwriting your numbers.
Wednesday	Yesterday they made their snakes & ladders style board — today is the time to play it! To challenge the children: • Try playing with two dice. • Get them to move the other players' counters. Please send photos ©
Thursday	When you're out on a walk can the count on things? For example buses, red cars, bicycles — always start from different numbers. Also complete the Counting On — Toy Problems activity sheet. This helps to show how useful this skill of counting on is. When you are ready move on to the Counting On activity — there are two sheets to choose from. Counting On 1 — Numbers up to 5 then 10. Counting On 2 — Numbers up to 10 then 20
Friday	Play to see how good your understanding is of where numbers come on a number line — you might not always be counting on from 0
