## Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware, the Government's plan is for schools to begin a phased reopening of schools across England from $1^{\text {st }}$ June. Since the announcement was made we have been using the guidance to consider ways of how to move forward. These are unprecedented times, which are extremely challenging for us all. I wish we were welcoming all children back after half-term, but unfortunately that is not possible. We will do everything we can to keep the children that are returning safe and happy and hope to welcome all of the children back as soon as we can.
