Our RE topic for this half term focuses on Pentecost and how we can show if we have an attitude of service by the way we live our lives, the way we treat others, and by our words and actions. The feast of Pentecost is a celebration of the gift of God's Spirit and its transforming power.

Through this topic, we will explore the transforming power of energy. We will learn about how Jesus appeared to the disciples after the resurrection; the message of Peter that the Holy Spirit will transform lives; how Paul's life was transformed; how the Holy Spirit makes Christians children of God and how the Spirit transforms lives through the 'fruits of the Spirit'. We will learn how the Pentecost Story continues in the Church today.

This week we will be thinking about 'Transformation' and I would like you to begin by exploring the transforming power of energy.

Begin by looking around your home and think about how these sources of energy are used around your home.

Look up in a dictionary or google the word 'transform' What does it mean? What does the word 'energy' mean? We and the world we live in are full of energy which can be transformed to good use for us and the natural world. Investigate and record ways energy or power is used in your home.
