



Class 1 Maths Planning Week beginning 22.06.2020

Day	Focus: Multiplication – Doubles to 10
Monday	Recap on Doubles from last week. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Vqp9OulJiIo What can they tell you about doubles?
Tuesday	https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=4U2QLjqripY – Dancing Doubles song Use a set of playing cards – take out the picture cards (King, Queen, Jack) and play ‘Snap’. If your don’t have any playing cards use the Snap resource sheet or make your own set using numbers 1-10.
Wednesday	Play ‘Show me the doubles’ game. You need: the Snap cards from yesterday and up to 20 objects (buttons, coins, milk bottle lids, clothes pegs, etc). Turn over the card – the number shown is what they have to double using the objects. So for example they turn over six. Lay six pegs out in a line then create another line to double them. Make sure they count the total when they have finished to check they are right. Take turns. If they are finding going up to 10 tricky, remove these cards from the pack.
Thursday	Draw the outline of a ladybird, on paper or in the sand if you’re on a walk down the beach. The adult then places between 1 and 10 buttons/coins/pebbles on one butterfly ‘wing’. Challenge your child to show you the answer to questions like “Can you double 6?” then clear the objects and ask other questions to allow the children to develop this concept.
