

## Class 1 Maths Planning Week beginning 29.06.2020

Day	<u>Focus</u> : Division — Halving
Monday	Watch <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=eBWTP84lcUI">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=eBWTP84lcUI</a> —Numberjacks 'A Game of 2 halves' as an introduction to halves.  As in the video can they watch you cut something in halve — a cake, a slice of bread and apple, etc and say "One whole makes two halves" — place the two halves together and pull apart — get them to see they are the same size, two equal parts.  Complete the 'Matching halves' activity
Tuesday	Watch: https://central.espresso.co.uk/espresso/primary_uk/subject/module/video/item884861/grade1/module883167/index.html?source=searchall-KS1-all-all&source-keywords=halves  Use a cake, pizza or slice of bread — with your close supervision, and they cut it in half? Send me a picture of the two halves. Alternatively, use the Paddington Halves activity.
Wednesday	Then watch this from Sesame Street:  https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=bo_svGP-iO4  Colour in half of the shapes on the activity sheet or the Colour the halves 2Do on Purple Mash.
Thursday	https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=663FhDCwhkY listen to the story  In an outside space use chalk, string, hula hoops, etc to create 2 separate circles –a circle for them and a circle for you.  Tell the child to collect 4 items (i.e. leaves, twigs, pebbles) then put half of the items in their circle and half in yours. Discuss their thought process –check any errors and try again with a different even number.
