

Class 1 Maths Planning Week beginning 06.07.2020

Day	<u>Focus</u> : Division – Sharing
Monday	Watch https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KTFJ9gjfAXg Talk about why sharing is important. Then watch https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WeXTDYS3E-4 but stop at 59 seconds to discuss is it ok not to share? How can it be fair? Continue watching to understand the concept.
Tuesday	Recap on what sharing means from yesterday. Give them 8 of the same items (cubes, pennies, twigs, raisins, etc) Ask them to share them so it is fair – so you and them have the same amount – a 'Fair Share' Model if you like "1 for me, 1 for you, 1 for me, 1 for you" and so on. Ask them to check that it's fair – how do they know? Repeat with 6 of the items – encourage them to say "1 for me, 1 for you" Check their accuracy. I always think this is fun with edible items on the two plates (with adult supervision) but can be equally as much fun at the beach, down the dene or in the house. Repeat with differing amounts, each time allow them to lead more and more.
Wednesday	https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=u_lhvMqaSzA Play this game - https://www.topmarks.co.uk/Flash.aspx?f=sharingv2 - select the 'moveable objects' option and again encourage the children to say '1 for me, one for you' We are not concerned about the ÷ symbol at this stage - more about the fact it has to be fair - equal amounts on both sides.
Thursday	Complete the 'Fair Shares' activity sheet. Than watch this cartoon about why fair shares are important for different reasons. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=efV27RcVrXU
