

## Class 1 Maths Planning Week beginning 06.07.2020

| Day | Focus: Division - Sharing |
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| Monday | Watch <br> https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KTFJggifAXg Talk about why sharing is important. <br> Then watch https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WeXTDYS3E-4 but stop at 59 seconds to <br> discuss is it ok not to share? How can it be fair? <br> Continue watching to understand the concept. |
| Tuesday | Recap on what sharing means from yesterday. <br> Give them 8 of the same items (cubes, pennies, twigs, raisins, etc) Ask them to <br> share them so it is fair - so you and them have the same amount - a 'Fair Share' <br> Model if you like "1 for me, 1 for you, 1 for me, 1 for you" and so on. Ask them to <br> check that it's fair - how do they know? Repeat with 6 of the items - encourage <br> them to say "1 for me, 1 for you..." Check their accuracy. <br> I always think this is fun with edible items on the two plates (with adult <br> supervision) but can be equally as much fun at the beach, down the dene or in the <br> house. Repeat with differing amounts, each time allow them to lead more and <br> more. |
| Wednesday | https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=u IhvMqaSzA <br> Play this game - https://www.topmarks.co.uk/Flash.aspx?f=sharingv2 - select the <br> 'moveable objects' option and again encourage the children to say '1 for me, one for you' <br> We are not concerned about the $\div$ symbol at this stage - more about the fact it has to be <br> fair - equal amounts on both sides. |
