This half term, we are learning lots of new topics of these include Rocks and Soils in Science and learning about the North East in Geography - these topics are what our homework activities are based on.



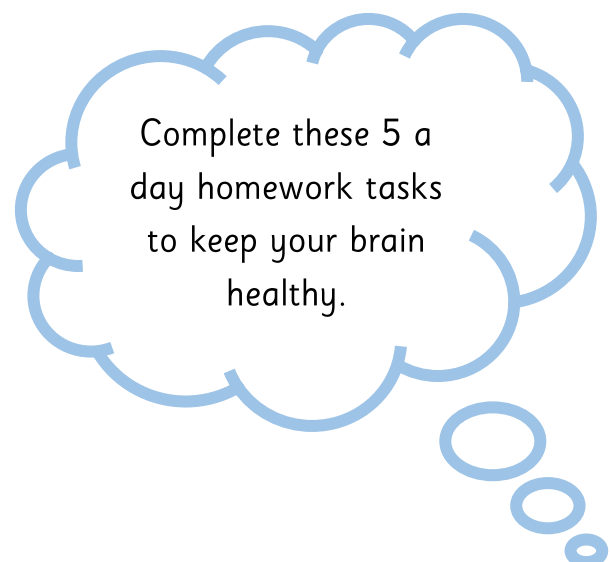

These activities are to be completed every day for 5 minutes each.

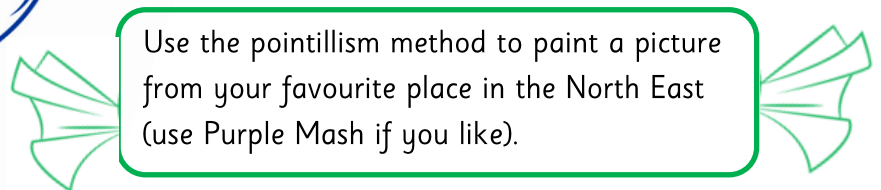
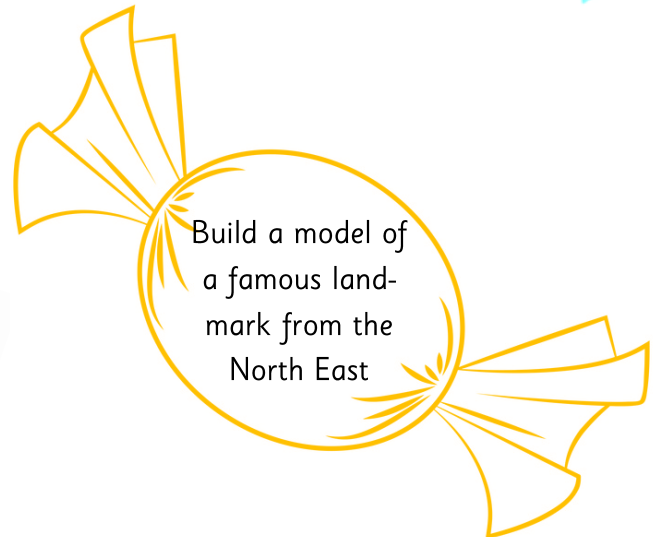
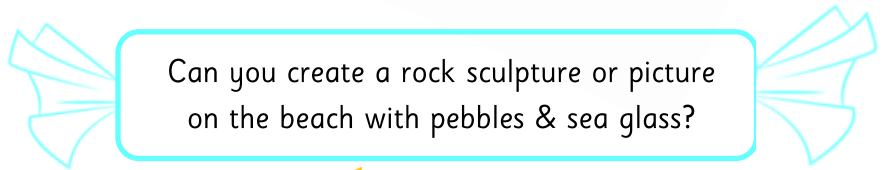
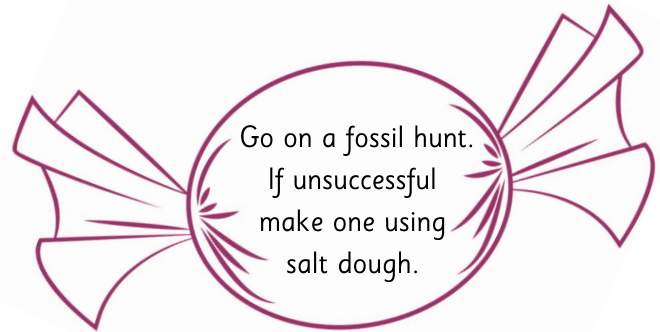
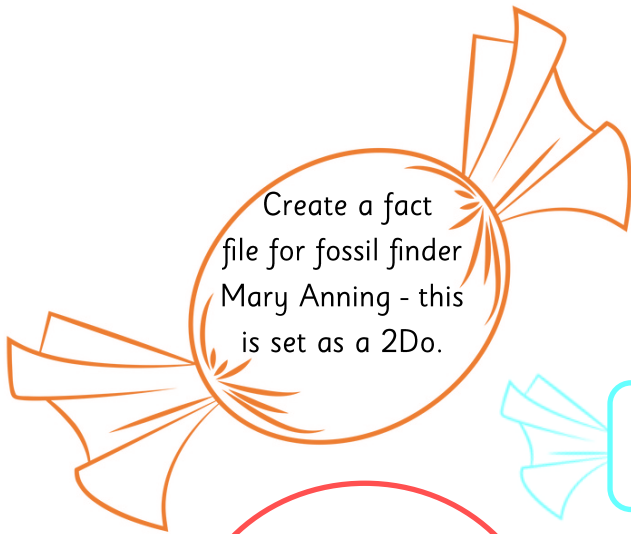
