Act out the story for someone in your house. You could do it yourself or use some of your toys as props.

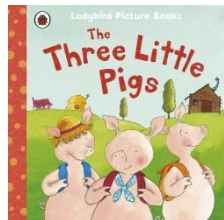
## Personal, Social and Emotional
