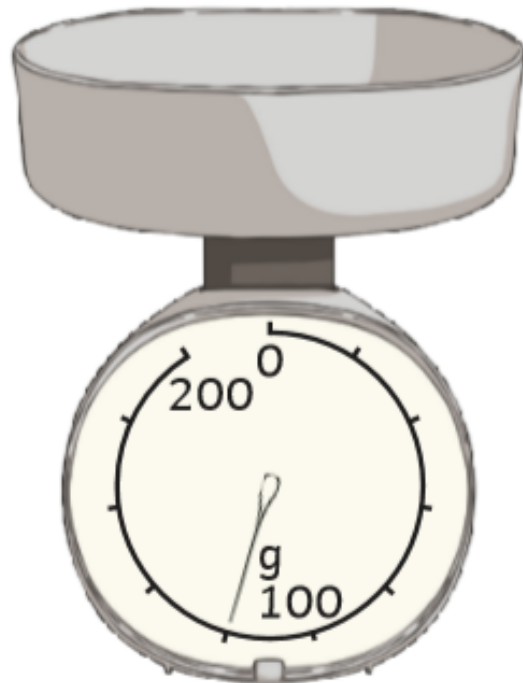
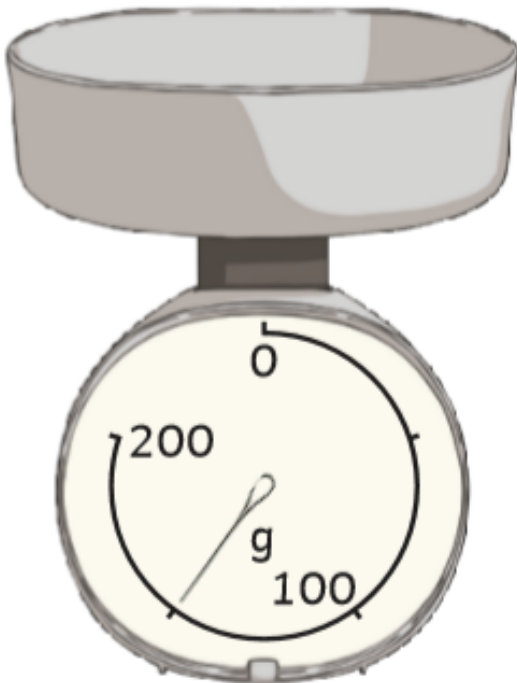

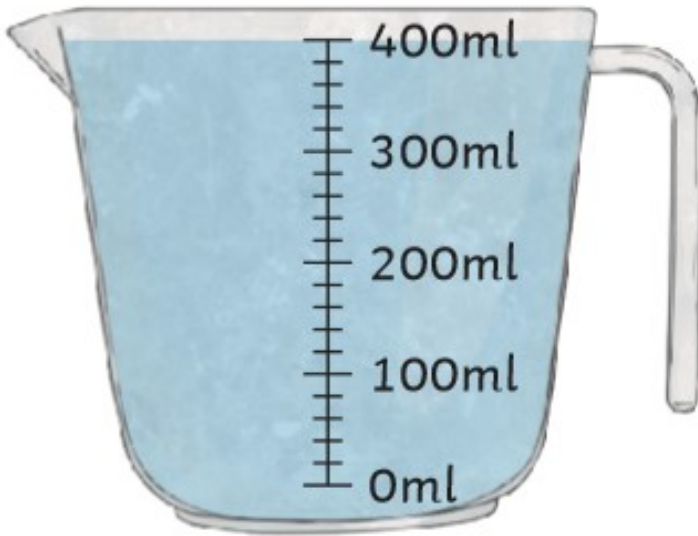

What measurement is each scale showing?



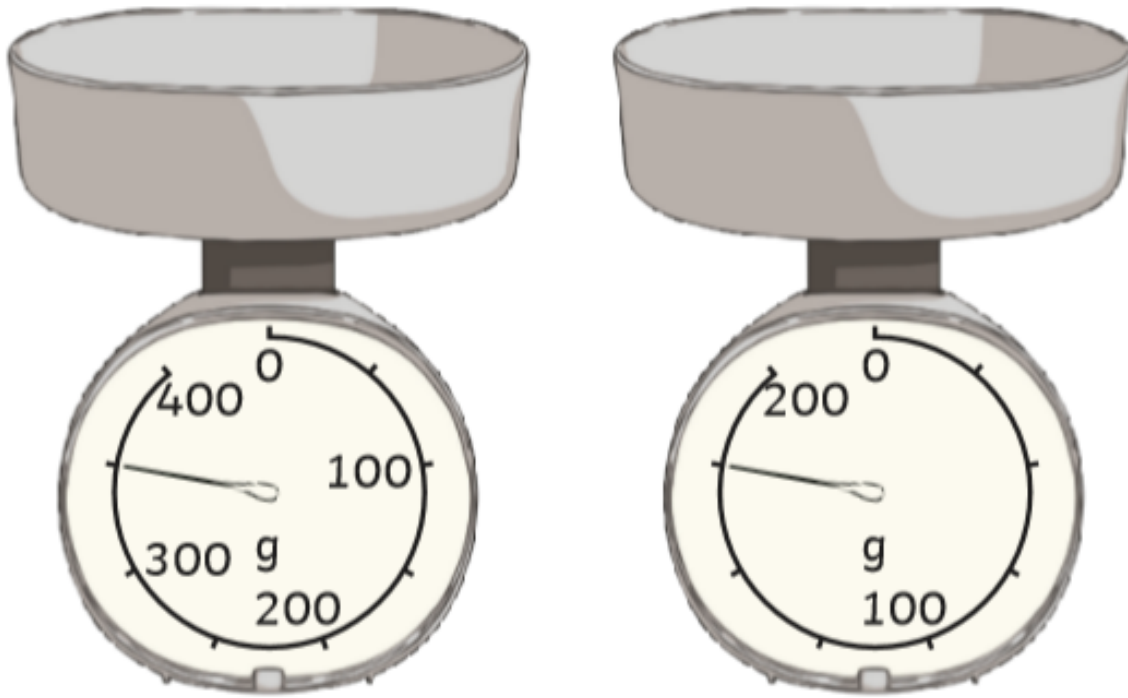
The beaker contains 400ml of water. If I pour out 80ml, how much is left?



How many 25p stickers can I buy with £3?

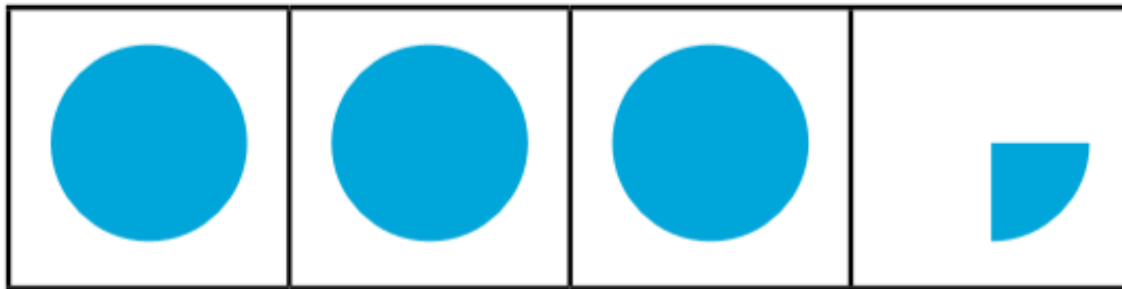
