### Focus: Introducing 0 and Comparing numbers to 5.

Remember all children are different so take the lead from your child; they may be ready to move beyond 5 or may only be working with numbers to 3.

Tuesday	<p><a href="#">Video- Session 2</a></p> <p>This video focuses on 0. Watch the video then draw a picture to represent the numbers to 5. How will you represent 0? You could go on a zero hunt around your house. How many 0s can you find?</p>
Wednesday	<p><a href="#">Video- Session 3</a></p> <p>Numbers to 5. The animals play a game that involves keeping score with numbers up to 5. After you have watched the video it's your turn to have a go at the throwing game. You will need a target, such as a hoop, and five objects to throw. How many land inside the hoop? How many land outside the hoop? Now record your score and then have another go! Did you score more or less this time? You might want to play with someone else in your house.</p>
Thursday	<p><a href="#">Video- Session 4</a></p> <p>We can practise comparing numbers to 5 using our fingers. Have a go at the activity <a href="#">here</a>.</p>
Friday	<p><a href="#">Video- Session 5</a></p> <p>Set up a teddy bears picnic and gather some food or objects to share. Explore sharing the food or objects between 2 teddies. Challenge- Share your items between 3, 4 or 5 teddies.</p>
