<p>Can you hear footsteps?</p> <p>Look at these pictures of three characters in the story. Each character's footsteps would make different sounds. Have a go at making footsteps like Jack and the Giant. Can you find things around the house that might make the same sound?</p>	<p>Counting Songs</p> <p>Use BBC Radio to help you listen to, learn and practise some number rhymes.</p> <p>I like 5 Little Monkeys.</p> <p>Mrs Hall's favourite is 5 Currant Buns.</p>
<p>Sleeping Giant</p> <p>Follow the PowerPoint and listen carefully, can you identify what has woken the giant?</p>	<p>Counting Weather</p> <p>In your tray on Purple Mash there is a file called Counting Weather. Observe the weather every day and complete the graph. At the end of the week count how many times you spotted each of the different weathers.</p>

Draw what you would like at the top of the beanstalk, get an adult to write for you or voice record your ideas.</p>	<p>Squares and Rectangles</p> <p>Squares and rectangles are shapes that have 4 straight sides. Can you draw a picture of a robot using 4 squares and 4 rectangles? You could draw squares for the head, body and eyes, and rectangles for the arms and legs.</p>
