Please can all parents bring their parent pay accounts up to date.



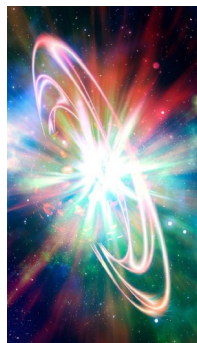
