**USE OF MOBILE TELEPHONES IN CONFESSIONALS** Following discussion at the Bishops' Conference, we have been advised that, due to the sacred nature of the confessional, clergy be requested not to have active mobile phones with them in the confessional. They should not just be put to silent mode but should be turned off before entering the confessional. Penitents should be requested to do the same. This is because, even if in silent mode, phones can still listen-in to conversations and artificial

intelligence algorithms identify items of interest to potential advertisers. This technology does not affect every network but must be presumed to be operative because it cannot be proven otherwise. Clergy should be aware of this when in any situation where confidential matters may be discussed.



**Excerpt from Reflection by David Frank:** ... In the Old Testament the priesthood was granted to the descendants of the tribe of Levi. The priesthood was very powerful in the Jewish faith but with power comes responsibility and, in the reading from Malachi, we see that this power, through pride, has led to corruption. Instead of a priesthood lived out in humility the priests have turned away from God and become contemptible and vile in the eyes of the people. The passage is a warning from God to all those who have power over others; if you do not keep to God's ways the people will cry out to God and God will come to their aid.

In contrast Paul's Thessalonians are living in a community that recognises the worth of each individual and where pride in oneself cannot find a home. This way of life is a gift from God. Following the example of Paul and his companions the Thessalonians are living sincere, humble lives by recognising the basic goodness of everyone and this brings the whole community close through their shared love of God. A real lesson for today.
