**Feast of the Douai Martyrs: Mass at Ushaw College** During the centuries when it was illegal to be Catholic in this country, priests were trained at the college in Douai in France. Many of them came back to England to serve the Catholic population and were martyred for the Catholic faith. Ushaw is the successor to the college at Douai, and an annual Mass to commemorate the Douai Martyrs has always been an important event in Ushaw's calendar. The martyrs' feast day falls on 30<sup>th</sup> October, but this year Ushaw's annual Mass to honour the Douai Martyrs will be celebrated on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> November at 12.30pm. Everyone is welcome to attend. Admission is free. Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 12.30pm.


